

A Brief History of David's Church

Founded in 1827, David's Church was built through the cooperation of Lutheran and German Reformed farmers settling in the Mahantango Valley of lower Northumberland County. The two congregations shared the building, worshiping every other Sunday with its own pastor. Each pastor served as many as six congregations in the area.


The German Reformed and the Evangelical Synod merged in 1934 to become the Evangelical and Reformed (E&R) Church of North America. Then in 1957, the E&R merged with the Congregational Christian Church to form the United Church of Christ (UCC).

David's remained part of a multi-church parish until 1969, when it became the Jordan Charge with St. Paul's UCC in Urban, with the Pastor serving both Lutheran and UCC congregations at both churches. In 1970, the Lutheran congregation at David's dissolved, and David's became solely a UCC church. In 2005, St. Paul's membership increased leading to the dissolution of the Jordan Charge.

Until February 2014, David's partnered with St. Paul's UCC in Sacramento, PA. David's now has a Pastor dedicated solely to our membership.

The original log church built in 1827 was destroyed by fire in 1863. The replacement church (the current sanctuary) was built of local mountain stone. In 1980 extensive renovations added a Church School wing, a fellowship hall in the basement, and updating many features with the sanctuary. The church also maintains a nearby cemetery through its Cemetery Association.
